## **Drydocks World delivers the world's largest multi-purpose OCV**



Drydocks World, the global maritime arm of Dubai World, has delivered "OSA Goliath", one of the world's largest multi-purpose Offshore Construction Vessel (OCV) at its Drydocks World–Pertama yard.

OSA Goliath is built for the Singapore-based group Coastline Maritime. With a dimension of 180x32x12 metres and 22,000 dwt, the vessel is as per Drydocks World the world's largest vessel in its class built so far. It is equipped with DP-3 and a 2,000-tonne crane to install offshore platforms and pipelines in deep waters.

In addition to "OSA Goliath", Coastline has a similar vessel, "Samson", currently under construction at the same shipyard, scheduled for delivery in the first quarter of 2010.
